

# A New Creative Arts and Education Hub for Bexhill









## Where we started...



- Jan 16 Old Job centre had been sitting vacant for over a year
- Bexhill Hive CIC formed with vision to transform the space into a high quality centre for community use and to provide a space for Creative and Digital Education in Bexhill







### Where we are now

The building is now a thriving centre, used by young people every day, bringing together Bexhill creatives and with new community activities launching in 2018





## Aims and Outputs in Hive Community Grant

#### Key Aims

- Renovate building for public use
- Create 5 classrooms
- Develop Basement space

#### Key Outputs

- Use of local construction suppliers
- 14 Jobs linked to Hive Development
- Increased engagement of young people into the area
- Community Use of the space









## **Outputs Delivered**

#### Building Renovation completed Feb 17

- Building renovated with 6 flexible learning spaces and large communal lobby space
- Basement practice rooms and studio space development funded additionally by Dv8 in September 17
- Local Bexhill based suppliers used in project







## Jobs and Young People

#### Jobs

 26 people now employed in Hive building in various capacities including new Hive Projects Coordinator

#### Young People

- Over 80 young people use the Hive every week on Dv8 programmes aged from 14- 24 years old.
- Over 150 Young people used the centre in August 17 with National Citizens Service
- Weekly evening sessions with Audio Active
- Range of new activities about to launch









## Community Use and Links

#### Local Residents Steering Group

- Steering Group of local residents (Bexhill Central) now being formed, first meeting to be held early March
- 3 Workshops funded per week to be delivered for community activities

#### Bringing Bexhill Creatives together

- Local creatives increasingly involved in projects at the Hive
- Bexhill based tutors and support workers employed at Dv8
- Streets of Bexhill to be based at Hive
- Creative Careers day to be held at centre in March





## Renovation Project Budget and Funding

#### Total Budget Proposed in Bid - £74k

- Match funding proposed Total £44k
- 30k RDC
- 15k Dv8
- 25k Locate
- £4k Arts Council

#### Final Renovation Project Costs £85k

- Match Funding Secured for renovation £55k
- £30k RDC
- £10k Empty Building Renovation Fund Locate East Sussex
- £20k Startup Ioan from Lets do Business
- £25k Dv8



## Project Revenue

- Annual rent, rates and running costs of building covered through Dv8 tenancy – Approx £75k per annum
- Other room hire- Approx £7k through summer NCS Hire
- Other Hive project funding Approx £35k for 2018 secured through project funding
- Audio Active Evening sessions £1k for evening workshops

Total revenue income or funding secured in 2017 / 18 – Approx £118k

## **Active Communities Grant**



- Project Coordinator post appointed Feb (14 hours per week)
- Steering Group made up of local residents (Bexhill Central) to shape provision
- Hive to host 144 workshop sessions (3 per week), half of which will have funded staffing
- £26k funded over 15 months
- For all ages
- Aims of fund:
  - Collective Control Increased involvement of local residents in activities and services and in the project's design and delivery.
     Participants enabled to lead, shape and develop the project
  - 2) **Social Links and ties**: Stronger connections between residents, enabling friendships and improved social networks.



## RDC Health Inequalities Grant

- April June 18 Create a Band Project Weekly evening workshop sessions
- June August 18 Games Development and Media
  Production Evening and summer workshops
- £10k funded up to Summer 18

## Aiming to Engage 30 NEET young people aged 13-24







## Further Developments

#### Planned Projects

- Community Arts venue
- Bexhill FM partnership
- Commercial Studio Use
- Summer Activites

#### CLLD partnerships

- Development of Community Arts Space
- Support for Self employment and traineeship programmes

#### Dv8 Study Programmes and other Provision

- Applications up 300% on this time last year
- 63% increase in Bexhill residents applying for 18/19
- Expanded Traineeships programme
- Aiming to support over 100 young people on Dv8 programmes next year







## Impact of RDC Grant



- Kick-started a unique project in Bexhill
- Promoting positive activities for young people and local residents
- Enabled a high quality space to offer training and support as alternative to mainstream FE offer, supporting vulnerable client groups positively
- Attracting young people from outside Bexhill into the town centre
- Providing a high quality space that will be used by local community groups
- Facilitating new networks of creative professionals and providing positive employment for local residents
