d) The Liberal Democrat Group and the Green Party Member for Old Town and Worsham Ward have formed a political group for the purposes of the allocation of committee seats in accordance with the Local Government and Housing Act 1989. The Group will be known as the Liberal Democrat \& Green Group. In accordance with usual practice for the purposes of committee seat allocation the vacant seat (Eastern Rother) has been allocated to the Group who last held the seat (Conservative).
